## **Fast Pitch Bat Check Protocol**

## **Updated April 2019**



If a bat has an ISF (2005) or WBSC certification stamp <u>or</u> an ASA 2000, ASA 2004 or new USA Softball (as shown below) certification stamp it is approved for use, unless it is one of the bats shown on the Softball Canada Non-Approved Bat List.

Adult men (U23 and above) may also use bats with an **ASA 2013** or the **replacement USA Softball** certification stamp.



## Adult male categories – U23 and above

All other bats are not approved for use. Non-approved Bats should be removed from competition and visibly marked (e.g. tape). Teams should be advised that attempted use during the game will, by rule, result in ejection.

## Notes:

- The Softball Canada Non-Approved Bat List includes those bats on the USA Softball Non-Approved with ASA / USA Softball Certification Stamp list that also do not appear on the WBSC Approved Bat list.
- Bats must meet all other requirements. (e.g. no cracks, severe dents, excessive wear, excessive tape, etc.)
